Key Achievements

- 9 vendors participated in Day 1 of the Projectathon, with 2 returning vendors and 7 brand new vendors
- Overall, 96 tests were conducted, where 36 no-peer tests were successfully completed, 11 tests are in progress, 1 test is partially verified and 48 tests are waiting to be verified by monitors
- Vendor familiarity with the Projectathon tool (i.e., Gazelle) and the communication channel (i.e., RocketChat) helped streamline the
 event
- IHE Catalyst and Infow ay Support Team resolved vendor onboarding issues for speedy troubleshooting

Challenges & Mitigations

- Evidence for Tests: A few vendors experienced issues in providing evidence for completed tests on Gazelle, w hich was quickly resolved through tech support with the monitor team
- Security: Some vendors experienced issues with security certificates (e.g TLS)
- · Proxy: Some vendors experienced issues with errors from their system when trying to connect to the Proxy

Day 1 FAQs

- Can vendors still pass CA:FeX even if they do not pass CA:Aud? Yes, because those two tests are not tightly coupled to allow for testing flexibility. How ever, the individual vendor results report will not show successful pass for audit requirements.
- Do vendors have to test for both PS-CA and PS-ON? Although we are offering the opportunity to test products against both national and Ontario-specific specifications, vendors are not obligated to complete tests for both PS-CA and PS-ON. The individual vendor report will simply state which tests were successfully completed (e.g. PS-CA / PS-ON).
